Interim Joint Local Well-being Plan - Update		<i>Discussion & Agreement</i>
Crynodeb o'r Materion / Summary of Issues		
Members of both Boards will recall that agreement was reached to develop an Interim Joint Well-being Plan. This plan will bridge the period between the cessation of the individual Public Services Boards and their respective Well-being Plans, and the implementation of a new Well-being Plan for the merged Board in 2028. The Interim Joint Well-being Plan will bring together the priorities being progressed by each Board into a single shared framework, providing strategic direction for the work of the merged Board from 15 September onwards. The Joint Merger Governance Task and Finish Group has convened on several occasions to support this work consisting of key representatives from both boards. Earlier reports considered at both boards illustrated how a mapping exercise had identified shared themes, areas of progress, and key objectives from the current Local Well-being plans. Analysis then informed an initial set of five proposed Themes which were previously shared. Subsequent discussion highlighted a clear preference to further streamline these Themes, focusing on a smaller number of priorities with defined targets. This direction reflected the need to maximise the impact of the newly merged board within the limited timeframe before the 2028–2033 Local Well-being Plan is adopted.		

Using the steer from the boards further joint work took place in the joint task & finish group to refine the priorities.

The resulting streamlined Interim Joint Local Well-being plan has now been presented and discussed separately at both PSB boards (**Appendix 1**) and it focuses on three key topical themes:

- **Food and Wellbeing**
- **Poverty and Hardship**
- **Climate and Nature Emergency Response**

It is respectfully suggested that this rationalised plan now provides a **clear and viable strategic direction** for the merged board for the remainder of the 2022–2028 Local Well-being planning period.
