Assessment of Local Well-being Involvement and Consultation report		<i>Discussion & Agreement</i>
Crynodeb o'r Materion / Summary of Issues		
The attached report has been prepared for consideration by the PSB, further to a period of consultation and engagement across Carmarthenshire, Ceredigion and Pembrokeshire. A small group of nominated officers, from across PSB members, have led on the survey development, communication and involvement opportunities, to collate qualitative evidence from residents in terms of their well-being. A total of 531 responses were received across Carmarthenshire and Ceredigion, supplemented by extensive engagement activity involving community events, the Ceredigion People's Panel, Carmarthenshire Youth Council, Local Nature Partnership and Bwyd Sir Gâr Food Partnership. Pembrokeshire PSB are currently preparing their involvement report and the next steps in terms of the Assessment of Local Well-being; however, timescales will differ slightly from this point onwards. We will continue to work closely with colleagues from Pembrokeshire on this work. The consultation demonstrates strong consistency in the issues that matter most to communities across Carmarthenshire and Ceredigion. Residents prioritise good health, economic security, strong communities, affordable housing, environmental quality and opportunities for future generations. While local differences exist, the findings point towards a relatively small number of interconnected challenges that should form the basis of the Assessment of Local Well-being. The PSB should now triangulate these findings with quantitative evidence, identify the key system-wide challenges affecting well-being, and use this insight to inform the development of future well-being objectives and the next Local Well-being Plan.
